



NATIONAL PARLIAMENTARY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM CHINA 2019

The Australian National University (ANU) in association with Peking University (PKU) in Beijing is offering an exciting opportunity for postgraduate students or recent graduates with a strong interest in China and Australia-China relations. The National Parliamentary Fellowship Program (NPFP) will select up to two fellows for foreign policy focused research stay of up to three months in Beijing, China, to commence in December 2019.

The NPFP aims to identify and foster the development of a new generation of leaders, promoting investment in Australia-China relations

through the networks which fellowship holders create.

Fellows will be affiliated with a research mentor at the NPFP partner in Beijing, PKU, pertinent to their primary policy research interest, and will attend relevant events offered through PKU and other leading Chinese research institutes and think tanks in Beijing, with the possibility of attending public policy hearings and briefings in the parliament.

Successful fellows will have the costs of roundtrip airfares and accommodation in Beijing covered and receive a monthly stipend of \$800.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the program, you must:

- > Be an Australian citizen;
- > Be a recent graduate of (within the last two years), or enrolled in a postgraduate program at an Australian university and in excellent academic standing (A-levels, graduated with distinction) at the time of the fellowship;
- > Be under the age of 35 at the time of the fellowship;
- > Have a strong interest and demonstrated previous research or professional experience in international relations, particularly vis-à-vis China, or in China's economic policy or security affairs;
- > Hold an Australian passport that has at least six months validity when the fellowship commences; and
